Conference rooms

We will be using a lecture theatre and breakout rooms in the Charles Carter Building in the South Campus (see the [campus map](#)), a virtually level 5–10-minute walk from the accommodation.



Accommodation



Accommodation will be in modern, single en-suite study bedrooms in Cartmell College (see campus map). Please indicate on the booking form if you have mobility issues and prefer a ground-floor room. There are communal kitchens (with kettles, irons and ironing boards) on each floor and rooms are supplied with coffee, tea and mugs. Hairdriers are not supplied. Unfortunately there are no double rooms available, but if you are bringing a partner we can ensure that you have adjacent rooms. Alternatively, you may be able to book a double room in the Lancaster House Hotel on the edge of the campus (see campus map).

Meals

Breakfast will be served in Barker House Farm, adjacent to the accommodation blocks. If you are arriving on Saturday (or staying on Monday night), evening meals will also be served here. During the conference, a buffet lunch will be served in the Charles Carter Building, where all the conference sessions will take place. The drinks reception and gala dinner with the SfEP will take place in the Great Hall (see campus map); there will be a shuttle coach service between Barker House Farm and the Great Hall but this is a pleasant walk on a warm evening.

Travelling to Lancaster

By train, Lancaster is only 2.5 hours from London, an hour from Manchester (with an hourly service from Manchester airport) and 2 hours from Glasgow. If you are coming by car, the University is not far from the M6 and there is parking adjacent to Barker House Farm. A useful compendium of travel information is available on the [SfEP website](#).
