Prices

- If you wish to bring a **partner** with you who is not attending the conference, the cost will be £124 for two nights (including dinner, B&B, but no lunches), but note that there are no double rooms available.
- If you wish to book **additional nights** before or after the conference, the cost will be £62/night for dinner, B&B, subject to availability. **Please let us know as soon as possible.**

Please note that these conference prices include a non-refundable deposit of £50.

New for 2019! Spread the cost

If you would like to spread the conference cost over three months, you may secure a place by paying £100 (non-refundable) by 4 June 2019, then setting up a standing order from your bank account to the Society for two payments of £139 each (£185 non-members) on 4 July and 4 August. An invoice detailing the balance and payment details will be sent to you from the office once you have paid your £100 deposit and you are then committed to setting up the standing order in good time for the payments to be processed. **This option is only available on bookings for the full (two-night) conference package.**

Cancellation

If you have to cancel your booking for any reason, please let us know. If you cancel before 1 July, we will refund your fee minus the deposit. If you have to cancel your booking after 1 July, a partial refund *may* be possible if we can fill your place. Late cancellations (after 1 August) will not normally be eligible for a refund.

Workshops and seminars

Booking for these will open in early July when more detailed information will be posted on the conference pages of the website. Sessions will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. If you will be away during this period, please contact the [conference organisers](#) in good time. If the necessary information is available, we may be able to record your preferences before you go away.

The venue



The Mile End campus of Queen Mary University is on a level site adjacent to the Regent's Canal. There are guided walks organised by Blue Badge guides. Alternatively you can follow the Regent's Canal from the College to the Olympic Park.

Conference rooms

We will be using a lecture theatre and breakout rooms in the Laws Building (No. 36 on the [campus map](#)), a five-minute walk from the accommodation blocks. Mid-morning and mid-afternoon refreshments and buffet lunches will be served in the foyer. There is also outside seating for use in favourable weather.





Accommodation

Accommodation will be in typical single en-suite study bedrooms, most probably in the Creed Building (No. 57 on the [campus map](#)) grouped into flats of eight rooms. Linen and toiletries are provided and rooms also include small fridges! Please indicate on the booking form if you have mobility issues and prefer a ground-floor room.

There are communal kitchens with coffee/tea-making facilities. Unfortunately there are no double rooms available, but if you are bringing a partner we will ensure that you have adjacent rooms.

Meals

Breakfast will be served in The Curve (No. 47 on the [campus map](#)), a few minutes' walk from the Laws Building and the accommodation blocks. During the conference, buffet lunches will be served in the Laws Building, where all the conference sessions will take place. Dinner will also be served in the Curve, which we will have exclusive use of during the evening. The bar will remain open until 11 p.m.



Travelling to Queen Mary

You can easily reach QMUL by underground from any of the mainline rail stations. It is no more than five minutes' walk from Mile End (Central, District and Hammersmith, and City lines) and Stepney Green stations (District and Hammersmith and City lines). Parking is extremely limited on campus (and available at weekends only) and you are therefore advised to use public transport, though there are public car parks in the vicinity.
